Significant events:

In the past year 15/16 there have been no significant events that related to infection prevention & control.

Audits:

Infection control audits were undertaken by:

Actions from this included:

Relevant staff immunisation records updated

Toys removed from both waiting rooms

Cloth Pillows removed from clinical rooms and replaced with wipeable pillows

Curtains removed and replaced with roller blinds

Plugs and nailbrushes removed from sinks

All sinks and surrounding worktops resealed

Old clinical waste bins replaced

Full review of the cleaning plan held with Minster– to include cleaning of portable fans.

Replacement of 3 patient examination couches

Replacement of hand pump soap and alcohol dispensers with new touch free dispensers in all relevant areas.

Replacement of carpet in downstairs waiting room, corridor and converted clinical room to hard flooring – Works identified and scheduled for completion May 17

Staff training:

Alison Allder continues to provide Infection, Prevention and Control induction training to all new starters and annual infection control updates to all staff.

The Infection Control Leads are due to attend their updates on the 24th November 2016 for their role, the training is provided by Michaela Hooper (the Infection Prevention & Control Nurse for Berkshire West CCGs.)

Infection Control Advice to Patients:

Patients are encouraged to use the alcohol hand gel/sanitiser dispensers that are available throughout the Medical Centre/Surgery.

There are relevant posters displayed in the Surgery – currently Norovirus, Influenza. These are reviewed on a regular basis
